Statement	Public transit is used to serve the needs of high school students residing in the City of Windsor, who are registered to attend an identified program at a school other than the normal school of attendance and at a distance of more than 3.2 km from the program school.
Approved Programs	<p>The following City of Windsor programs have been approved for public transit:</p> <p>Greater Essex County District School Board Forester – Programs (ESL and other approved) Herman – French Immersion Massey – Community Living Walkerville – Windsor Centre for the Creative Arts - Community Living</p> <p>Directions PASS – Mason – Windsor Program Turning Point – Mason – Windsor Program Maryvale New Beginnings I & II</p> <p>Windsor Essex Catholic District School Board Catholic Central – English as a Second Language - Community Living St. Joseph – French Immersion Work Matters</p>
Procedures	<p>All schools will submit a list of eligible students to WESTS. Eligibility lists are then submitted to Transit Windsor by WESTS. Students report to the Transit Windsor sales office to get their transit pass and photo.</p> <p>The type of pass will be contingent on the program of study that a student is enrolled. They will be issued either a semester restricted bus pass or a monthly restricted bus pass.</p> <p>Eligible students not on the list submitted to Transit Windsor must get a school issued Transit Windsor authorization form in order to get a bus pass.</p> <p>Lost or stolen passes will not be replaced and will be the</p>
