<p>Statement</p>	<p>A Day Care can be identified as an alternate address for purposes of pick up or drop off for those students who are eligible for transportation.</p> <p>The Day Care must be licensed under the Day Nurseries Act to qualify and must be within the same school boundary as the home address.</p>
<p>Procedures</p>	<p>Students must be eligible for transportation from their home address and attending an approved Day Care within the school boundary for their home address.</p> <p>The student must be using the Day Care on a consistent basis either for before or after school for each day that they attend school. There is no transportation provided to the Day Care for those days that the student does not attend school.</p> <p>The parent will provide the address of the Day Care as the alternate address for transportation on the transportation application, school admission form or through the electronic input system for those schools not utilizing paper applications.</p> <p>Temporary or short term requirements for Day Care will not be accommodated.</p> <p>Students attending a Day Care that is outside the student's school boundary will not be eligible for transportation unless there are no approved day cares or day care spaces in the school boundary or if otherwise approved by the Superintendent of Business for the applicable board. Students attending a day care that is in boundary for a school but have an out of boundary home address will not be eligible for transportation.</p>
