The plan will be developed by the respective Board's Special Education Services in collaboration with the consortium and in consultation with the student's parents/guardians and home school staff.</li> <li>1. This policy and the Student Transportation/Health Plan (Appendix A) and Driver Accessibility Guidelines (Appendix B) will be included as an addendum to the WESTS Consortium Operator contracts and training on the policy will be included as a driver/monitor requirement.</li> <li>2. The Superintendent of Special Education for the respective boards and, where appropriate, the General Manager of WESTS, will identify and communicate roles and responsibilities with regard to the implementation of the individual Student Transportation/Health Plans to the following: <ul> <li>The Bus Operator</li> <li>The aprents/guardians of the student Transportation Plan</li> <li>The appropriate members of the school administration; and</li> <li>The student for whom the Student Transportation/Health Plan has been developed.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	
Responsibilites: Boards	<ol> <li>The Superintendent responsible for Special Education, or their designate, will, in consultation with parents/guardians and home school staff, annually identify students with disabilities and/or health conditions who require special transportation services. Such identification will, whenever possible, be made prior to the commencement of the student's attendance at school.</li> </ol>

	2. The Superintendent responsible for Special Education, or their designate will work with the General Manager of Student Transportation, or their designate, to
	develop an individual Student Transportation/Heath Plan (Appendix A) for each student identified as requiring special transportation services.
	3. The Student Transportation/Health Plan will include details of the student's assistance needs with respect to transportation to and from school and provisions for boarding, securement and deboarding of students, as applicable, following the Driver Accessibility Guidelines (Appendix B).
Responsibilities of Bus Operators	<ol> <li>The Bus Operator will ensure that all of their Bus Drivers are made aware of individual student's needs with regard to boarding, securement and deboarding and/or any other needs identified in the Student Transportation/Health Plan.</li> </ol>
	<ol> <li>Access to Student Transportation/Health Plans will be provided to the Bus Driver and any appropriate training will be completed, including on the safe use of accessibility equipment and features, acceptable modifications to procedures in situations where temporary barriers exist of or accessibility equipment on a vehicle fails, and emergency preparedness and response procedures that provide for the safety of persons with disabilities.</li> <li>The Bus Operator will keep a record of the training</li> </ol>
	provided, including the dates on which the training was provided and the number of individuals to whom it is provided.
Responsibilities of Bus Drivers	<ol> <li>The Bus Driver will ensure that the student is transported safely according to their needs as per the Student Transportation/Health Plan.</li> <li>The Bus Driver will follow all consortium procedures for the transportation of students with disabilities</li> </ol>

Responsibilities of Parent/Guardian	<ol> <li>The Parent/guardian will:</li> <li>Advise the school, Student Transportation and/or the Bus Operator of any disability, medical or other condition affecting the safe transportation of the student and communicate any changes to such.</li> <li>Help identify tools or strategies that may help the driver and/or monitor while transporting the student.</li> <li>Work collaboratively with the School Board, WESTS, and the Bus Operator in the accommodation of the student.</li> <li>Consent to sharing the student's personal information as required by this Policy.</li> </ol>
Responsibilities of School Administration	<ol> <li>School Administration will:</li> <li>Advise Student Transportation and parents of any relevant issues while at school during the day.</li> <li>Advise the Bus Driver if there are any relevant issues that may affect the safe transportation of the student at the end of the day.</li> </ol>
Responsibilities of Students	Students will: 1. Follow the bus rules. 2. Advise the driver and/or monitor of any emergency health issues or concerns, if possible.
