Terms	The following definitions for the terms used throughout the policies are identified below and are applicable to all policies unless otherwise specified.
Definitions	Certified Service Animal – is defined as any animal that has been individually trained by an organization or person specializing in service animal training to perform tasks to assist persons with a disability in a need related to their disability.
	Designated School – is the school that has been determined by the School Board to be the home school for a student based on their address and/or program of learning.
	Primary Home Address – is the address that the student resides on a permanent basis with a parent/guardian. In cases of Joint Custody the parents/guardians must determine which home will be designated as the Primary Home Address.
	Alternate Address - is the address of a Daycare Centre or caregiver that the student attends before or after school.
	Secondary Home Address – is the address that is not the Primary Home Address in a joint custody arrangement.
	Out of Boundary – refers to any school that is not a Designated School as per the above noted definition.
	Walk Zone – is the area from the Primary Home or Alternate Address that does not meet the eligibility criteria as per Policy E-01 Transportation & Eligibility Policy.
	Designates – refers to the individuals that have been identified by the parent/guardian (including the parent/guardian) as approved to take a JK/SK or other identified student off the bus.

Courtesy Ride – is a bus ride for students who are within the walk zone but have applied and been approved for transportation as per Policy E-05-Courtesy Ride Policy & Procedure.

BusPlanner – is the software system utilized by Student Transportation in the development of routes and administration of student busing services.
