<p>Statement</p>	<p>In accordance with the requirements of Regulation 613, Seat Belt Assemblies, (RRO_1990, Reg. 613 under the Highway Traffic Act) WESTS will provide child booster and car seats for students transported in contracted passenger vans.</p>
<p>Responsibilities</p>	<p>WESTS will:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Provide child booster seats for all students travelling on a passenger van with less than 10 seats and who are under the age of eight (8) years or weigh between 18 and 36 kg (40 to 80 lbs) or stand less than 145 cm (4 ft. 9 in.) tall. 2. Provide forward facing child car seats for all students travelling on a passenger van with less than 10 seats and who weigh between 9 and 18 kg (20 to 40 lbs.). 3. In collaboration with the local police services, ensure bus drivers transporting young children in child booster and car seats are trained in the proper installation of the equipment to ensure that the seats are firmly secured in their vehicle. <p>All equipment shall remain the property of WESTS.</p> <p>Parents/Guardians will:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Ensure that students are sitting properly in their seats and that their seat belts are buckled before the vehicle departs when picked up at their bus stop. 2. Verify their student’s height and weight to determine appropriate child booster/car seat requirement. <p>School Administration will:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Ensure that students are sitting properly in their seats and that their seat belts are buckled before the vehicle leaves the school at the end of the day.
